Effective June 29, 1918, new maximum prices for these districts were established by the Fuel Administration. The new prices which applied to the entire output of the two districts, regardless of the thickness of the seams from which derived, were (inclusive of the 45-cent price increase because of the November, 1917, wage increase) as follows: run of mine, \$2.70; prepared sizes, \$2.95; slack \$2.45.
