Here they are uniquely portrayed in 167 vintage postcard images, most dating from the first half of the twentieth century, when these urban landscapes were in transition to modern times. Featured are evolutionary stages of three Spanish-era plazas--Main, Military and Alamo--plus the River Walk and Travis, San Pedro and Brackenridge parks, in addition to images of a half dozen more.
