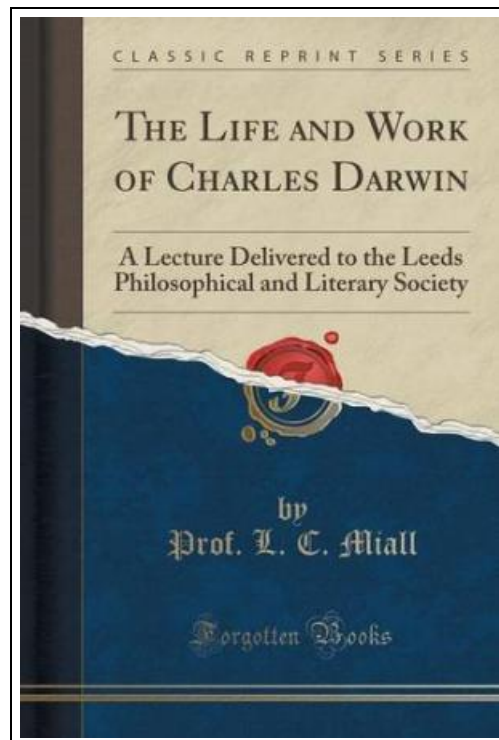

This process allowed for specific genes or physical attributes to be weeded out of a familial line and others to be perpetuated for the survival and improvement of a species. Knowing the connection between Charles and Erasmus Darwin, one must wonder if Charles would have ever created his theories on evolution had it not been for the work and passion of his grandfather. While the work of both men saw widespread debate, it can be argued that Charles' work provoked the most international interest. Exploring the life of Charles helps readers understand how he was led down the path of exploring both natural philosophy and evolution, and how he ended up creating one of the most important theories in biology to date.
